COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) amending Annex I to Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the listing of perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA) its salts and PFOA-related compounds

Persistent organic pollutants (POPs) are organic substances that persist in the environment, accumulate in living organisms and pose a risk to our health and the environment.

POPs are regulated worldwide by the Stockholm Convention and the Aarhus Protocol. These pieces of legislation are implemented in the European Union by the POPs Regulation.

## **Requirements and Exemptions:**

- Shall not be manufactured, or placed on the market as substances on their own from 4 July 2020
- Shall not, from 4 July 2020, be used in the production of, or placed on the market in:
  - a) Another substance, as a constituent
  - b) A mixture
  - c) An article, in a concentration equal to or above 25 ppb of PFOA including its salts or 1000 ppb of one or a combination of PFOA-related substanes

None of our products contain substances in concentrations exceeding the maximum Concentration Value (MCV) as postulated in aforementioned regulations.
